

FLD DEAN'S REGULATION

No. 6/2026

Decision on the Establishment of the Research Ethics Committee

Preamble

In accordance with the long-term strategic objectives of the Faculty of Forestry and Wood Sciences (hereinafter referred to as the “FLD”) of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter referred to as “CZU”), namely the promotion of excellence in research, the protection of research participants, forest ecosystems, landscapes and natural resources, as well as compliance with national and international standards of ethical conduct, and with the awareness that academic rights and freedoms are inseparably linked to adherence to general and professional ethics, I hereby establish, with effect from 28 April 2026, the Research Ethics Committee of the FLD, CZU (hereinafter referred to as the “Committee”).

Article 1

Establishment of the Committee

1. Pursuant to the internal regulations of CZU, the strategic documents of FLD, and the commitments to responsible research, the Committee is hereby established as an advisory and supervisory body of the Dean of FLD, CZU.
2. The principal mission of the Committee is to promote ethical research and to assess research projects and scientific outputs conducted under the auspices of FLD, CZU, with the aim of ensuring compliance with ethical, legal and professional standards.
3. The Committee's competence extends to employees and students of FLD, CZU, and, where applicable, to external researchers whose research is carried out in cooperation with FLD, CZU.
4. The Committee shall consist of three members. The Chair and members of the Committee shall be appointed and dismissed by the Dean of FLD, CZU.
5. The Committee shall operate and act in accordance with the Dean's Regulation of FLD, CZU governing the Statute and Rules of Procedure of the Committee.

Article 2

Final Provisions

1. This Decision was discussed by the Dean's Board of FLD, CZU on 1 April 2026 and approved by the Academic Senate of FLD, CZU on 27 April 2026.
2. This Regulation shall enter into force and take effect on the date of its signature.
