Getting to the Venue

By Air: Václav Havel Airport Prague

By taxi: approx. 20 minutes. UBER is the official airport service, available via app, kiosks, or staffed counters.

By public transport: (~45 min) Take trolleybus No. 59 from Terminals 1 or 2 to Nádraží Veleslavín (Metro Line A). Continue by Metro Line A to Dejvická. From there, take bus No. 107 or 147 to Zemědělská univerzita. Walk approx. 10 minutes to the venue.

By Car:

By Public Transport (Train or Bus):

From Florenc Bus Station: Metro Line B > Můstek > transfer to Line A > Dejvická > bus No. 107/147 > Zemědělská univerzita

From Hlavní nádraží (Main Train Station): Metro Line C · Muzeum · transfer to Line A · Dejvická · bus No. 107/147 · Zemědělská univerzita

Public Transport Tips

Tickets available via machines, mobile apps (e.g. PID Lítačka), counters at metro stations, newsstands, or onboard (card only).

90 minutes: 40 CZK





24 hours: 120 CZK

72 hours: 330 CZK

Accommodation

Useful Extra Information

Currency: The local currency is the Czech crown (CZK). Approximate exchange rate: 1 EUR \approx 25 CZK. Credit cards are widely accepted, but it's handy to carry some cash (especially coins) for transport tickets and small purchases.

Weather: Early October may have mild afternoons (up to 15 °C or even 21 °C), but evenings are noticeably cooler. Recommended layered clothing (sweaters, medium-weight jacket or light coat), water-resistant shoes, and optionally a compact umbrella.

And don't forget to check the forecast before packing to adapt to any weather variations.

Language: Czech is the official language, but English is widely understood in hotels, restaurants, and transport services.





Others: Prague is generally safe. Keep an eye on your belongings in crowded areas.

Locals appreciate polite greetings such as Dobrý den (Good day).
