Introduction, problem analysis:

- importance of the topic, the reason why the topic has been chosen by the student
- brief introduction to the issue, recent discoveries in the field (incl. recent publications), unresolved topics, etc.

- by what methods and approaches aims likely will be achieved, main hypotheses

Time schedule:

- milestones and time table

Benefits and result applications/importance:

- for science
- for practice (esp. in applied research)

Relationship to other projects:

- previous research experience
- other projects at the department
- interdisciplinary cooperation
- individual task or part of a complex research
- cooperation with other institutions
- International cooperation

Expected outcomes:

- Expected publications, conferences, etc..

Funding:

- Expected financial and material requirements of the project
- Funding (department, grants, own resources, sponsors, etc.)
