Stanisław Lem European Research Prize #LemPrize

Lem Prize has been established to commemorate the 100th birthday of the great Polish visionary and science fiction novelist, Stanisław Lem, awarded doctorate *honoris causa* of Wroclaw Tech in 1981.

Lem Prize is addressed to young European scientists (under 40 years of age).

Lem Prize is awarded for a recent discovery or major achievement in broadly understood fields of science & engineering, with strong elements of technology, interdisciplinarity, creativity, and vision.

Lem Prize Committee, chaired by Prof. Reimund Neugebauer (President of the Fraunhofer-Gesellschaft), consists of 12 distinguished scientists.

Lem Prize applications must be submitted by 15 October 2021.

The winner will be announced on 15 November, during the annual celebrations of Wroclaw Tech anniversary.

Lem Prize winner receives monetary reward of 100 000 PLN.
